Mobility Online – Applications & Documents

1. I cannot upload my documents to Mobility Online. Why?

Document upload is only enabled during the official submission periods:

- First semester (March–July): **November 1–15**
- Second semester (August–December): **June 1–15**

2. Can UADE International receive documents by email?

No. All documents must be uploaded to the Mobility Online platform. Once the system is open, you will be notified by email.

3. Which documents must be uploaded?

The full list of required documents will be detailed in the application instructions provided after nomination.

Language Requirements

4. Is the language certificate required only for Spanish?

Yes, only a Spanish language certificate is mandatory.

5. What level of Spanish do I need?

The required level is specified in the admission guidelines. Please check the fact sheet or contact UADE International for confirmation.

6. I am currently studying Spanish but do not yet have the certificate. What should I do?

Upload proof of enrollment in a Spanish language course to Mobility Online.

7. If Spanish is my mother tongue, what should I upload instead of a language certificate?

You should re-upload a copy of your passport.

8. What type of Spanish certificates are accepted?

Any recognized certificate of Spanish proficiency will be accepted.

9. If I plan to take courses only in English, do I need to upload an English certificate?

No. Instead, upload a signed Word document including your full name and the statement: "I will only enroll in courses taught in English."



Academic Information

10. How are credits assigned to courses?

In Argentina, credits are not used. Courses are measured by contact hours.

11. Can I register for courses in any undergraduate program?

Yes, you may enroll in courses across different programs.

12. Is there a minimum or maximum number of courses I must take?

No, there are no restrictions.

13. Can I take both undergraduate and graduate courses regardless of my level of study?

Yes, you may do so.

14. Where can I find course syllabi?

After your university nominates you, you will receive an Excel file with course codes and titles. With this, you can request up to 8 syllabi.

15. When can I prepare my Learning Agreement?

After you have been officially accepted by UADE.



Documents & Recommendations

16. Who should write my letter of recommendation?

It must be written by a professor or academic advisor at your home university.

17. In which language should my motivation letter be written?

It can be written in either Spanish or English.

18. Does the motivation letter have to be handwritten?

Yes, it must be written in your own handwriting.

19. Is there a template for recommendation or motivation letters?

No, UADE does not provide a template.



Visa & Regulations

20. Is it mandatory to apply for a student visa before traveling to Argentina?

Yes, obtaining a valid **student visa** is a requirement.

21. Can I take both undergraduate and master's level courses?

Yes, you may enroll in both.

22. Are May 15 and November 15 final deadlines for completing the application?

No. These are the **final deadlines for uploading documents**:

- May intake: May 1–14, until 23:00 (Argentina time)
- November intake: November 1–15, until 23:00 (Argentina time)

Housing & Insurance

23. Does UADE provide on-campus housing for exchange students?

No, UADE does not have on-campus housing. However, a list of housing suggestions will be provided to admitted students.

24. What type of health insurance is required?

Health insurance must cover the entire academic period, from the first day of classes until the last official exam date.
