Andreas Moerke, professor and researcher at Worms University of Applied Sciences (Germany), delivered guest lectures for students in the Global Business and Financial Management programs.








#### **UNITED STATES**


# DOING BUSINESS IN LATIN AMERICA AND DIGITAL MARKETING & COMMUNICATIONS
